Citizens to Be Heard There was community opposition to the closure of the Commerce and Quinlan Emergency Rooms, citing public health risks and long travel times to Greenville for emergency care. Concerns were highlighted about the increased emergency room wait times and overcrowding at the Greenville hospital post-closure of the satellite emergency rooms. Mr. Boles addressed a few of the public questions and provided operational facts regarding the emergency departments and noted the Greenville ER consolidation improved patient throughput and decreased average wait time from 233 to 164 minutes within one week of the Commerce and Quinlan emergency room closures.
